Craft Instructions & Additional Craft Options



“Let the little children come to me...”

Today's Craft Instructions:

PENCIL TOPPER - I go to Jesus and I have Jesus in my heart!

Supplies:

1. White Paper (can be copy paper, sketch book paper, construction paper)
2. An unsharpened pencil or the longest sharpened pencil you have at home
3. Another sharpened pencil or writing utensil
4. Scissors
5. Clear tape
6. Red marker or crayon
7. Ruler

Instructions:


1. Measure and draw two 2" x 2" squares on your white paper
2. Cut out both of your squares
3. On one square, draw a big heart – with a red crayon or marker
4. On the other square, write "JESUS."
5. Lay the eraser-end of the unsharpened/long pencil over one of the squares (on the blank side – so either "Jesus" or the heart is facing outward) and tape the pencil onto the paper
6. Position the second square over top of the first one with the "Jesus" side or heart side facing outward so you can see it.
7. Tape the papers back to back with the pencil in the center
8. Now for the best part... Twirl/roll the pencil between your palms and watch what happens. **Jesus is in your heart!**



Additional Craft Option 1A: Children Holding Hands Cut Out


Supplies:

1. White Paper (can be copy paper, sketch book paper, construction paper)
2. Sharpened pencil
3. Scissors
4. Crayons/markers to decorate when finished



Instructions:

Fold a construction paper into 4. Draw the picture in one part of the folds as above. Then, cut the paper while folded following the outline of the picture. Take note to cut through the edge of the arms and legs so that when you unfold, you will have 4 children holding hands together.




Additional Craft Option 1B: Children Holding Hands Circular Paper Cut Out

Supplies:

1. White Paper (can be copy paper, sketch book paper, construction paper)
2. Sharpened pencil
3. Circle pattern to trace on the paper, such as a plate
4. Scissors
5. Crayons/markers to decorate when finished

Additional Craft Option 2: Race to Jesus Board Game

Supplies:

1. White Paper (can be copy paper, sketch book paper, construction paper)
2. Sharpened pencil
3. Crayons/markers
4. Manipulatives for game pieces
5. Dice

Instructions:

1. Use a pencil and draw a big squiggly "S" shape to create the game board.
2. Add lines to create the spaces on the game board.
3. Draw a few "bridges" to connect sections of the "S"
4. Label several spaces with commands such as "roll again", "go back 2", "skip ahead 1", "cross bridge", etc.
5. Draw children at the starting place and draw Jesus at the last space of the game.
6. Color and decorate the game board as you wish.
7. To play: Each person rolls the dice on their turn and moves the appropriate number of spaces.
8. Kids are playing to see who will get to the end to reach Jesus first!
